

Best Ways to Start a Presentation

1. Share an experience that relates to the topic. Try adding humor, if possible.
2. Bring up a fact or statistic that most people might not be familiar with.
3. If you're working in a team, try starting the presentation with an act or skit.
4. Opening with a relevant quote can help set the tone for the remainder of your speech.
5. Asking a **What If...** question can immediately draw your audience in and invite them into your thought process.
6. A powerful statement or phrase can catch the audience's attention by keeping them guessing about what's coming next.
7. Asking a rhetorical or direct question can be an effective way to begin your speech.
