- Share an experience that relates to the topic. Try adding humor. if possible.

- If you're working in a team. try starting the presentation with an act or skit.

- Asking a **What If...** question can immediately draw your audience in and invite them into your thought process.
- A powerful statement or phrase can catch the audience's attention by keeping them guessing about what's coming next.
- Asking a rhetorical or direct question can be an effective way to begin your speech.
