

# FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

## Q. Can I apply if I am currently enrolled in the course?

- A. Of course! Hiring will be contingent on receiving an A- or higher in the course and undergraduate students maintaining a cumulative GPA of at least a 3.0.  
For Peer Tutoring, you will still take the exam. We ask that you only take up to what you know.

## Q. Where can I obtain a copy of the application to apply as an SSC Peer Leader for PLTL, SI, or Peer Tutoring?

## Q. Which courses are you all hiring for?

- A. Please visit <https://studentsuccess.utdallas.edu/about-the-ssc/be-a-leader-tutor/> for a list of typical courses the SSC hires for. The list of courses is a generic list and is subject to change. Courses may be added or removed from this list depending on faculty and leader support.

## Q. Which courses do I qualify for?

- A. You qualify for any course we are hiring for in which you received an A- or higher. If taken during spring 2020 or later, CR will be accepted.

## Q. Am I only allowed to be a peer leader for courses I have taken at UT Dallas?

- A. For SI and PLTL, yes. Peer Tutoring will accept CR from testing or transfer credit from another college/university with a grade of an A- or higher, depending on the course. Please remember that all Peer Tutoring candidates must take and pass an exam.

## Q. How do I receive the invitation for testing?

- A. Candidates will be sent an invitation for testing after full completion of the application. Testing dates for Peer Tutoring are listed on the application.

## Q. In the application, why do I need to rank my preferences?

- A. Ranking preferences allows for programs to take the candidate's preference into consideration. However, preference is not guaranteed.

## Q. Do I have to upload an official transcript?

- A. No. You can upload a current unofficial transcript. More information at <https://registrar.utdallas.edu/transcript/unofficial/> on how to download your unofficial transcript.

## Q. Can I apply if I have taken the honors version of the course?
